End of Year 11 Arrangements

As we near the end of what has been a challenging academic year, I am both proud and extremely grateful for how students, parents/carers and staff have pulled together during this time.

Year 11 students will officially leave the academy on **Friday 28th May**. On this date students will meet in their tutor bases. Period 1 and 2 will be spent in the Princess Suite where Year Books will be distributed and students will have the opportunity to sign shirts and say goodbye to teachers. Prom tickets will also be issued to students who have paid in full. Students wishing to pay and collect after this date will need to arrange a suitable time to do so.

Mr Butterell and Mrs Little will be in attendance to assist and answer any questions. Students will leave site between 11.00am and 11.15am through the main reception doors.

After half-term

After half-term, we will be running a **Post 16 transition timetable for three weeks**. This will be a series of lessons designed to prepare you for sixth form, college or resits. The lessons are open to anyone who wishes to attend, regardless of your plans for September.

Attendance to the Post 16 lessons is **optional for most students**, however, anyone who has applied for our 6th Form, another 6th Form or college course must continue to come to school for the subjects they are doing, (e.g. if you are studying Biology A-Level, you will need to keep attending Biology lessons).
