In terms of organisation for the day, students will be split into either participants or spectators and will be based in bubbles with their tutor groups.

Participants

Spectators

All student spectators who are unable to participate in an event for medical reasons should still attend in their full PE kit and will play an important leadership role for their tutor group on the day.

ALL students will then be dismissed at 3pm from Sutton Community Academy.

It is hoped that the day will again be one of the highlights of the year for many students and give everyone the opportunity to experience the 'community spirit' that is so strong at Sutton Community Academy.
