Covid-19 measures from 19th July 2021

You will have seen the government's announcements in regard to the operation of schools from Monday 19th July, as the country proceeds to 'step 4' of the 'roadmap' of easing Covid-19-related restrictions.

As ever, we will be following the government guidance closely, and you will note that Monday 19th July is only a few days before the end of our term on Wednesday 28th July 2021.

Because of this, we will not be changing our current approach to the management of classes or the school day before the end of the summer term. When we return in September, however, there will be no more 'bubbles' or staggered starts.

You will also have read about changes to the rules on self-isolation which will apply from 16th August. In the meantime, may I continue to urge you to continue with any home testing routines and, also to follow the government guidance closely in the event of a positive test or your developing symptoms of Covid-19.

I will communicate further in relation to the arrangements for the start of term in the next few days.
