Information for Parents

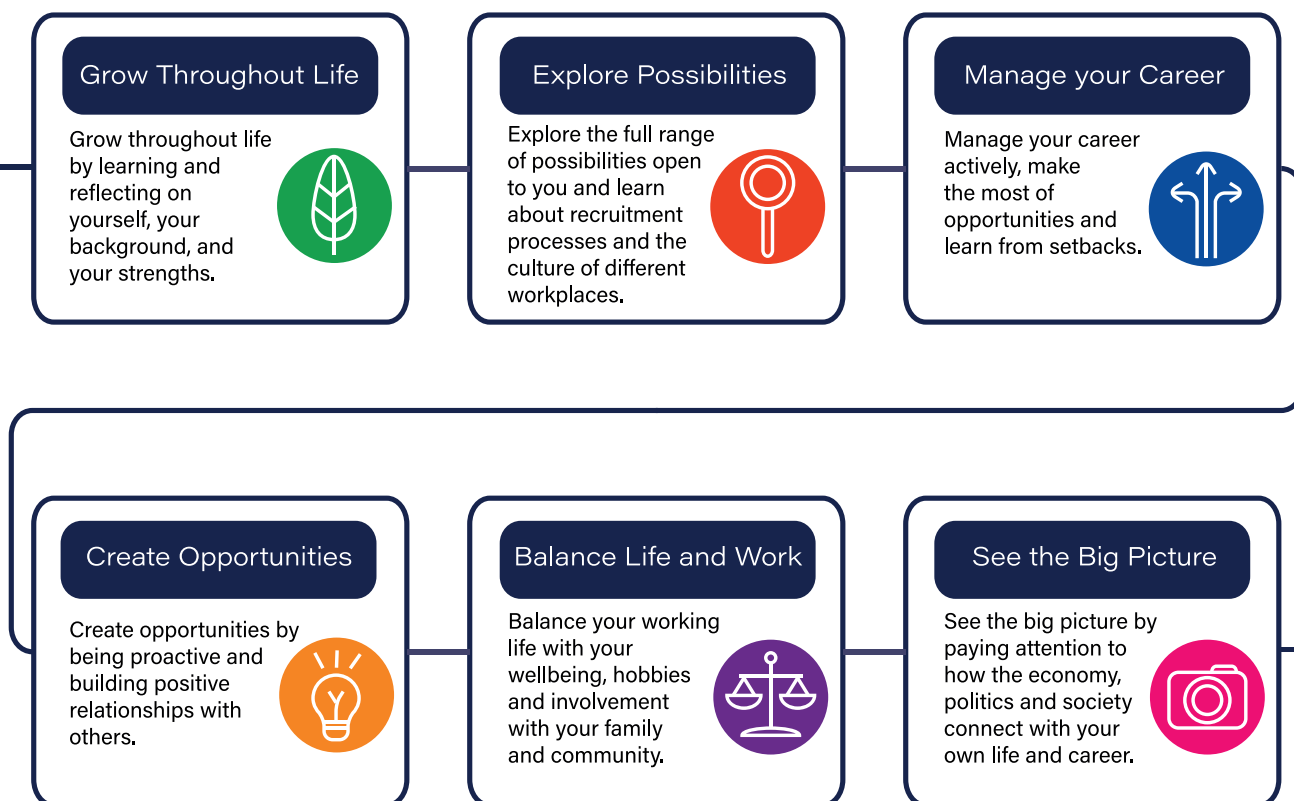
