This is important as it ensures that all students and their families have a fair opportunity to obtain feedback from the Academy. If anything becomes unclear throughout the event which requires more than this length of time to discuss, please arrange with the teacher another opportunity to discuss further.

Prior to the evening, you will be required to book your appointments with your child's teachers.
