



Dear Parent/Carer

Firstly, I would like to thank all parents/carers for their continued support in ensuring students are attending the academy equipped and ready to learn. It is also pleasing to see improved attendance across the year group in what is a very important year.

To further support our Year 11 students, we are now pleased to offer our intervention/support programme which has been developed to ensure all subjects areas are able to provide additional support for students in their subject. In most cases this will run from 3 – 4pm.

It is worth noting that simply giving students access to more doesn't always relate to better outcomes. We have therefore put together a system which enables staff to invite students to attend targeted intervention/support sessions after school as and when required. To enable this to happen we will be operating a two-week intervention system for departments to 'request' the students they wish to see on a particular night. 'Requests' will be made at least 24 hours prior to each session. This will mean that this subject has the priority over any other subject for that student on that night.
