

## Addendum to Behaviour and Rewards Policy for SAAP Centre

## SAAP 3 Strike rule

To help promote positive behaviour the SAAP Centre has established a '3 strike rule' sanction. Students who do not follow our behaviour policy will accrue a strike (sanction). A strike will be given for persistent behaviour issues or serious behavioural concerns.

- Strikes will be noted on the behaviour board.
- Upon the 3<sup>rd</sup> strike, students will accrue a same-day detention of either 30 minutes or, if behaviour issues persist, 60 minutes.
- Serious behavioural issues may result in internal isolation at SCA, external isolation at one of our partnership schools, or a fixed-term suspension (FTS).

## **Rewards**

As part of our aim to drive positive behaviour within the SAAP Centre, we have implemented our own unique rewards system, 'The Avatar'. This system aims to reward our students in every aspect of the school day. Students are assigned their own unique avatar logo. They earn positive points for every positive attribute they make and do – including but not limited to: quality of work, attitude to learning, good behaviour, making the right choices. This list is not exhaustive and is reviewed and updated regularly based on the needs of the Centre, and staff and student feedback.

Student progress is clearly visible on the rewards chart at the front of the classroom; a healthy reminder to each student that we are aware that they are making the right choices. The system starts afresh each day, reinforcing the concept that <u>'every day is a new start - a new chance to aspire.'</u>

## <u>Upgrade</u>

On the collection of 5 avatar points students can exchange these for <u>1 x rewards ticket</u>, which is placed in the prize draw box. At the end of each term SAAP will host an <u>Afternoon Tea</u> rewards day, in which all students and their parents will be invited to celebrate the end of the term in style. 3 awards are available. Tickets will be drawn and a £20 high street voucher reward will be issued for the following:

- Most improved behaviour
- Best attendance
- All round progress made.
