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

The SCA6 Learning Envionment

We believe all students flourish in an environment that is calm, structured and free from disruption. Our sixth-form students appreciate our high standards and understand how it makes Sutton Community Academy a happy and safe place to learn.

We have significantly developed and enhanced our Post-16 provision at Sutton Community Academy, with the complete refurbishment of our dedicated Sixth Form Centre. Along with a large social space and fully equipped kitchen area, there are numerous classrooms and study rooms for students to use, allowing them to complete their independent study uninterrupted. Additionally, there is a brand new IT suite furnished with new desk top computers, exclusively for the use of sixth form students.

All Post-16 students have a personal tutor, who will meet with their tutees for a registration session each morning. Additionally, our Head of Sixth Form and Careers Advisor are also based in the Sixth Form Centre, so are always on hand to offer support and advice to students.

The Sutton Way

We believe school is about more than just gaining qualifications. With our Post-16 provision, we place a strong emphasis on the development of students' character.

The Sutton Way describes our school culture and the way we do things. It explicitly sets out our expectations and reminds us of the habits that will secure success in school and beyond.

The Sutton Pledge is our flagship character awards scheme. Students are challenged to complete a wide range of community, cultural and character-based pledges in order to achieve Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum awards. As part of the pledge, students have opportunities to influence and make a positive impact within their local community.

We offer an extensive programme of opportunities to support and enrich our ambitious SCA6 curriculum offer.


Students represent the academy in numerous sporting teams and perform in our drama productions, music concerts and dance festivals.

We also offer the highly popular Duke of Edinburgh Award as well as lots of extra curriculum opportunities, including, Maths Challenge, STEM Club, musical instrument lessons and reading and writing competitions throughout the year.

Students in every tutor group elect student representatives to sit on the Student Council in order to contribute to key decision-making across the school.

Our students understand their role as citizens of the world and participate in many curriculum trips to destinations such as the National Justice Museum, The National Holocaust Centre and Museum and local religious and cultural institutions. Further afield, Sutton students are embarking on trips to Everest Basecamp, Skiing in Italy and The European Organization for Nuclear Research in Switzerland.

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Careers

High quality careers education and guidance is critical to our students' futures. It helps to prepare them for the workplace by providing a clear understanding of the world of work.

Through a wide variety of activities, lessons, visits and one-to-one career appointments, our sixth form students are able to gain valuable knowledge about jobs and courses that may be of interest to them. Our dedicated careers advisor is available in the Sixth Form Centre to provide the support students need to help them make a well-informed, realistic decision about what to do after leaving Sutton Community Academy.

Students are taken to visit universities, Further Education colleges and apprenticeship providers. They undertake work experience, mock interviews and attend our very own, highly regarded careers fair. We hold the Career Mark in recognition of the outstanding level of support and guidance we offer to students.


