I look forward to meeting and working with you to ensure that your child receives the first-class education they deserve.




Expert Teaching

Beyond the Classroom


We offer an extensive programme of opportunities to support and enrich our ambitious curriculum offer.

Students represent the academy in numerous sporting teams and perform in our drama productions, music concerts and dance festivals.

We also offer the highly popular Duke of Edinburgh Award as well as lots of extra curriculum opportunities, including, Maths Challenge, STEM Club, musical instrument lessons and reading and writing competitions throughout the year.

Students in every tutor group elect student representatives to sit on the Student Council in order to contribute to key decision-making across the school.

Our students understand their role as citizens of the world and participate in many curriculum trips to destinations such as the National Justice Museum, The National Holocaust Centre and Museum and local religious and cultural institutions. Further afield, Sutton students are embarking on trips to Everest Basecamp, Skiing in Italy and The European Organization for Nuclear Research in Switzerland.




Careers

Transition

It is essential that all Year 6 students arrive at Sutton Community Academy feeling excited and well-prepared to take the next steps in their educational journey.

Our transition programme is well established, offering students plenty of opportunities to get to know their new school community. All new students are placed in a small tutor group that they stay with from Year 7 to Year 11. Each tutor group is led by a tutor who is responsible for the pastoral care of their tutees during their time at Sutton Community Academy. Students spend time with their new tutor and tutor group during transition days. The tutor is the first point of contact for parental enquiries, therefore we invite student families to our Meet the Tutor evenings in the summer term.

Once students have joined us in September, we host a schedule of activities to ensure our new students make friends, get to know their teachers and settle into the routine of the school day.
