Re: Closure of Sutton Community Academy Sixth Form Provision

I hope this letter finds you and your family well.

I am writing to share an important update regarding the future of our sixth form provision at Sutton Community Academy. The Department for Education's Regional Director has now formally approved our request to close the sixth form, effective from **1 September 2026**.

This decision has not been taken lightly. It follows a thorough review and consultation process, during which we carefully considered the long-term sustainability of our post-16 offer and how best to serve the needs of our students. As you are aware, we will not admit a new Year 12 in September 2025; our current Year 12 students will advance to Year 13 to finish their studies by June 2026.

While change can be unsettling, I want to reassure you that our commitment to your child's future remains unwavering. The DfE's approval comes with a clear expectation that we will provide robust and high-quality support to ensure every Year 11 student secures an appropriate and ambitious post-16 pathway—and we are fully committed to delivering on that promise.

We understand how important this stage is in your child's journey, and we have put in place a comprehensive programme of support, including:

- A strong Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance programme from Year 7 onwards to help prepare your child for the future beyond school.
- One-to-one careers guidance with our advisor to explore all available options.
- Post-16 provider events and information evenings to help students and families make informed choices.
- Application and interview support to ensure students have the best chance of success.
- Ongoing mentoring and tracking to ensure every student is on track and confident about their next steps.

We are proud of the resilience, ambition, and potential of our students, and we will continue to work closely with each of them—and with you—to ensure they are fully supported in making a successful transition beyond Year 11.
