Dear Parents/Carers,

As we move further into this crucial stage of the academic year, I am writing to share a number of important upcoming events and support opportunities designed to help our Year 11 students prepare effectively for their GCSE examinations.

We will begin with a **Year 11 Assembly this Friday 27th February**, during which students will receive key information regarding next steps, expectations, and the range of support available to them.

From next Monday 2nd March, Period 6 sessions will return to being compulsory to all, offering additional structured support and curriculum time for all students. I am incredibly grateful to staff who are giving up their own time to put on additional sessions for students in Year 11.

A series of subject specific immersion days will follow shortly after. These include:

- **Science Immersion Day – 5th March**
- **English Immersion Day – 12th March**

On **12th March**, we will also be issuing the **Year 11 Progress Reports**, which will contain mock examination results, predicted grades, and other relevant performance information to support discussions at home.

To further assist students in their preparation, we will be holding the **Year 11 Revision Evening for parents and carers on Thursday 19th March at 4pm**, where you will have the opportunity to explore strategies and resources to best support your child in the leadup to the summer examinations.

In addition, we will soon be launching **Sunrise Sessions**, providing students with supervised access to the library and a quiet working environment before school. These sessions are intended to help students establish productive study routines and make effective use of independent learning time.

We are also piloting a **Focus Friday** initiative in English, targeting specific skills where knowledge gaps have been identified through Question Level Analyses of mock examination papers. This targeted intervention aims to strengthen students' confidence and proficiency in key areas.

During the final week of this term, we will be holding an **Achievement Week**, designed to support students in completing coursework across their remaining GCSE subjects.

Looking ahead, we will be conducting **Walking, Talking Mocks in English** on the following dates:

- **17th April**
- **1st May**

These sessions will guide students through exam-style questions in real time, helping them to develop effective exam techniques.

We will also be running a number of **Easter Holiday revision sessions**, the timetable for this will be shared on **11th March**.
