As part of our ongoing commitment to ensuring that every Year 11 student is supported to achieve their full potential, we are taking a proactive approach to identifying where additional guidance, encouragement and intervention may help students make the strongest possible progress as they move through this important stage of their education.

Following discussions with teachers and a review of students' current progress, a small number of students have been identified as benefiting from some **additional, targeted support** at this point in the year. The evening is designed to provide a focused opportunity for you, your child and key members of staff to work together. You will be able to book **appointments with the relevant teachers**, allowing us to discuss current progress, identify any areas where further support may be helpful, and agree practical steps that will help your child continue to move forward with confidence.

We are providing this additional support because we want to ensure that students have every opportunity to make the progress of which they are capable. **Your support as parents and carers is an important part of this process**, and we would strongly encourage you to book and attend the appointments offered, if required. Working together, we can ensure that the additional guidance provided by the academy is reinforced at home and that your child is fully supported in making the most of the opportunities available to them.

Appointments can be booked through **MCAS**, where the relevant teachers will be available for you to select. The targeted nature of the evening means that conversations can remain purposeful and focused on the subjects and areas where additional guidance is likely to make the greatest difference.

If you have **not received any communication or invitation regarding the Progress Support Evening**, please be reassured that this is positive news. It means that your child is currently making **really pleasing progress** and is continuing to meet the expectations we have for them.
